

LOSS OF ANSWER BOOK(S) OF A CANDIDATE

If a candidate's paper is lost after having been received by the Superintendent of the examination or by one of his Assistants and if his result in the other subjects/papers entitles him to be declared successful in the examination with or without the addition of marks in the missing paper, he may be given an option either:

- to appear in the missing paper and the marks obtained by him in that paper shall be duly entered in the Result Sheet and his result declared accordingly or
- (ii) to accept award for the missing paper calculated on the basis of the average of the marks obtained in other Board's papers by him.

In case of dispute as to whether a candidate's paper was duly received or not, the findings of the Chairman shall be final.
